At the NESSFTA annual meeting in 2007 a change in the bylaws was approved which changed the way the judges are selected to judge the National Open Championship. You are receiving this letter because you are an owner of a dog that was qualified to enter the National Open Championship held in 2007. The by law states:

The owner of a dog that has placed in an Open Stake and has qualified for entry in the previous year's National Open Championship shall be eligible to cast a vote in the judge selection process. However, no person shall be entitled to more than one vote irrespective of the number of dogs owned that have earned qualification. If a qualifying dog has more than one registered owner only one owner will be eligible to vote. However, if a second dog qualifies that has the same combination of registered owners, the owner not previously entitled to vote may also cast a vote.

My records show that you are eligible to vote in the judge selection process for the 2009 National Open Championship judges.

Attached is a ballot for those judges. Please complete the ballot and return it to me not later than May 31, 2008. Please note that the ballot must include your manual signature.
