The Central Wisconsin Sporting Spaniel Club (CWSSC) will host a Spring Field Trial on Saturday March 20 and Sunday March 21, 2010 in New Glarus, Wisconsin on the Oasis Game Farm property N9074 Cty Rd. J, New Glarus, WI. (Note: For the GPS use Blanchardville, WI. The grounds are west of New Glarus, off of Rt 39 and Cty Rd J) **The OPEN All-Age Stake 1<sup>st</sup> series will begin on Saturday March 20th with the Amateur Stake 1<sup>st</sup> series following and then alternating series until conclusion on Sunday March 21st. Puppy Stake will be run on Sunday March 21st not before 9:00 am . Depending on the size of the Open Stake, we may need to start early on Saturday morning. The exact start time will be stated on the running order.**

Our Open and Amateur judges will be Randy Bartsch of Minot, ND and John Meyer of Lake Elmo, MN and the Puppy Stake judges are Don Brunn from Elkhorn, WI and Danelle Oliver from Dorsey, IL.
