Dear Fellow Field Trialers:

The Northern Colorado Springer Spaniel Club cordially invites you to our annual spring field trial, Saturday and Sunday, March 6 and 7, 2010. We will be holding the trial near Weld County Road 37 between Weld County Roads 16 and 18, just a few miles east of Fort Lupton, Colorado. The cover that we will use for the trial is grass and weeds and there will be plenty of opportunities for our talented spaniels to show off.

Our All-Age judges are Tom Schoene and Kevin Rutherford. The Open Stake will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and the Amateur Stake will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday. The Puppy Stake will be held not earlier than after the second series of the Amateur. We will not have a formal training session before the trial. Our puppy judges will be announced before the trial.

The trial headquarters is the Best Western Del Camino Inn and Suites located at I-25 and Exit 240. The phone number for the motel is 720-494-1925 or toll free 800-528-1234. Please ask for the rate for the Northern Colorado Springer Spaniel Club. The discounted hotel rates are \$65.99 plus tax per night for a king size bed or one queen and \$71.99 per night for two queens or for a mini suite (one queen and a fold out sofa bed, but roomier). A continental breakfast is included. Be sure to mention the Northern Colorado Springer Spaniel Club to get these rates. The headquarters motel does not allow dogs in the rooms but there is an area to air dogs behind the motel. Other motel options are 1) the Super 8 Longmont-Del Camino, 303-772-0888. Dogs are allowed in the rooms if they are not left unattended. 2) Comfort Inn, 303-684-6779. No dogs in the room. 3) Days Inn, 303-651-6999. Dogs allowed for a \$20.00 charge. The hotel is approximately 15 miles from the grounds. There will be lunches available at the grounds both days. We are planning a dinner with the judges on Saturday night. More information on that will be available with the running order.

Please remember that this is Colorado and the weather could bring anything from temperatures in the upper 60's to rain or snow. Please be prepared for any kind of weather.
