Dear Field Trialers,

We would like to invite you to the Rocky Mountain Springer Spaniel Association spring field trial, **Saturday and Sunday February 27 and February 28, 2010.**

Judges:

The judges for the Open and Amateur All-Age Stakes will be **Tim Edwards and Chad Betts.**

Stakes

Open All Age **Saturday February 27, 2010 start at 8:00 AM.**

Amateur All **Age Sunday February 28, 2010 start at 8:00AM.**

The puppy stake will be run on Sunday beginning no earlier than the completion of the 2nd series of the Amateur.

Grounds

The grounds are about 2 miles east of Fleming, Colorado at the northeast corner of Logan County Roads 36 and 83. For safety reasons, we would appreciate it if you would approach the grounds from the east. From Fleming please take U.S. 6 about 3 miles west of Fleming to CR 85. Go north on CR 85 about 1.5 mile to CR 36. Then go west on CR 36 about 0.5 mile to the grounds.

From the north take State Highway 55 south from Crook (exit 149 from I-76) to CR 38. Go east about 1 mile on CR 38 to CR 85.

Go south 1 mile on CR 85 to CR 36. Then go about 0.5 miles east to the grounds. A map is included with this premium list.

Training:

We will not hold a training day and training will not be allowed on the trial grounds.

Headquarters:

The Headquarters Motel will be the Super 8 Motel in Sterling about 20 miles west of the grounds. It is near the top of a hill about 0.5 miles east of I-76 at exit 125 (U.S. 6 exit). You can see the motel from the interstate.

Hotel rates are \$58.00 per room plus tax, which includes high speed internet and a continental breakfast. Dogs are allowed in the room for an extra fee. There is some room for airing dogs. The phone number is 970.522.0300. Mention RMSSA when making your reservations.

There are 2 other hotels at the I-76/U.S. 6 exit, immediately east of I-76. They are a Comfort Inn, phone 970-522-3700 and the Ramada Inn, phone 970-522-2625. The Ramada Inn has a 24 hour restaurant. There is also a Best Western about 0.5 mi west of I-76.

RVs

There will be no overnight camping allowed at the grounds. There is an RV campground with full hookups just west of the Ramada Inn. Self contained RV's can stay at a campground in Fleming right under the water tower. The Fleming campground does have a dump station.

Meals

Lunches will NOT be available at the grounds either day. There is a 24-hour restaurant at the Ramada. Several other restaurants are available in Sterling. West's County Market in Fleming also serves food. There is a grocery store and restaurant in Haxton.

Unless the dog is in season, or you have a veterinarian certificate, scratches received after the closing date will not be refunded.

Those of you who have attended our fall trial in the past know that the weather tends to be cool. However, Colorado weather in February, like most other times of the year, is variable. Please be prepared for anything from warm, sunny weather to cold and possibly snowy.

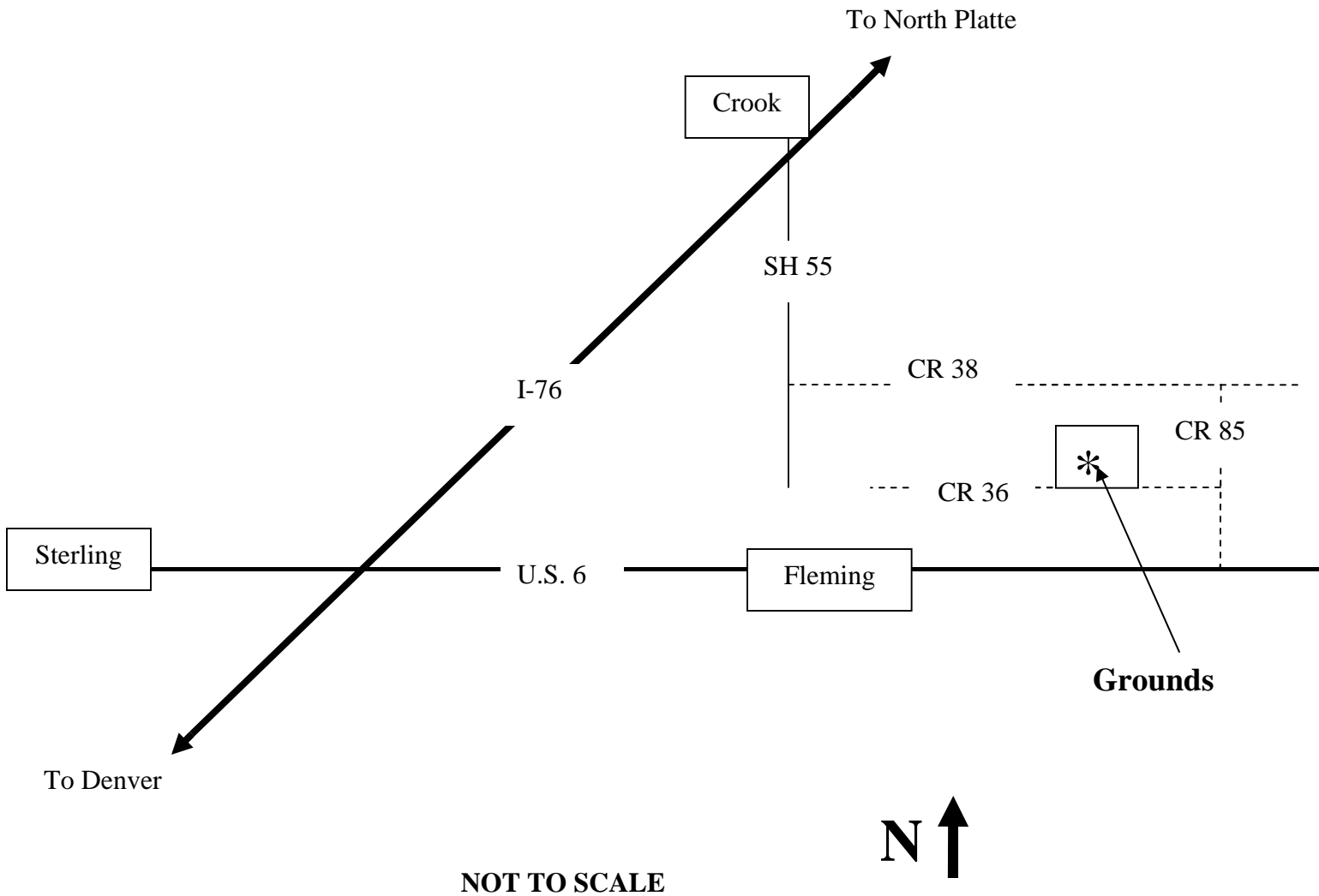
