### Directions to trial grounds . .

**Coming from the South:** Take Hwy 65 North to 190 East about 11 miles, to  
J28/Strathmore (Hwy 176). River Island Country Club will be on your right.  
Turn left and continue for about 4.5 miles until you reach the Kincade Wildlife  
Management Area on left.

**From the North:** Take Hwy 64 South to Strathmore Road (approx 5-7  
miles from Headquarters) Turn left following the curve of the road  
slightly past the power plant. Look for the entrance on your right.

There will be double orange flags or signs at the entrance. Enter and  
follow dirt road to its end at covered picnic area.
