Stay on Pine until Shankle Ave. Left. Take the First Right, this will be Bayette, 1st fork go right. Next fork is a hard left and the next split stay right. This will now be Co. Rd. 2585.

It will make several turns, you will pass a pump jack on your right as the road changes to gravel. The entrance is ¼ mile on the Rt.

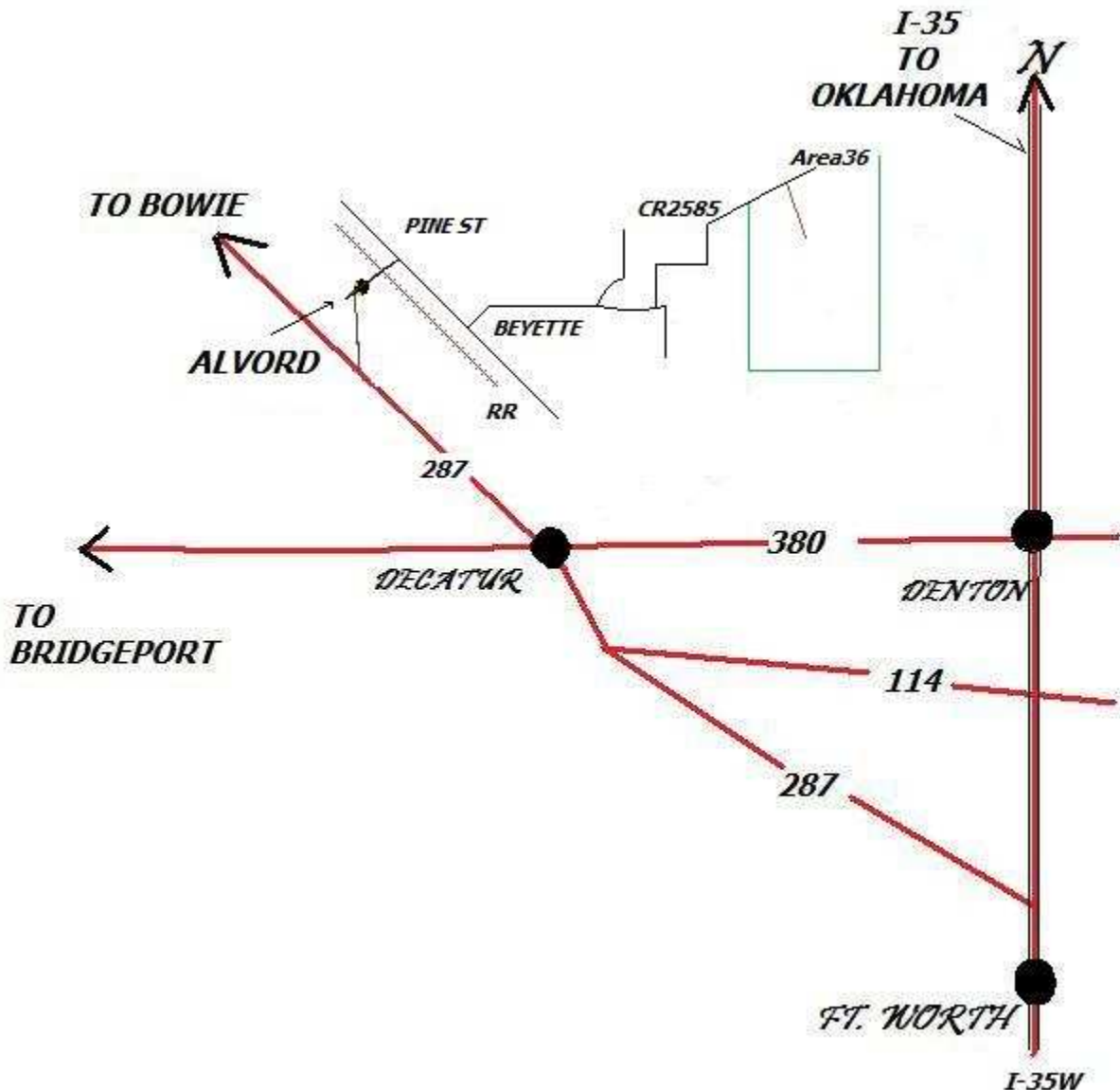
