**Directions**

Grounds

The Grounds are located about 2 miles east of Fleming , Colroado at the northeast corner of Logan County Roads 36 and 83. For safety reasons please approach the grounds from the east.

From Fleming: Please take US 6 about 3 miles west of Fleming to CR 85. Go north on CR 85 about 1.5 miles to CR 36. Then go west on CR 36 about 0.5 miles to the grounds.

From the North: Take Highway 55 south from Crook (exit 149 from I-76) to CR 38. Go east about 1 miles on CR 38 to CR 85.

From the South: Go south 1 mile on CR 85 to CR 36. Then go about 0.5 miles east to the grounds.
