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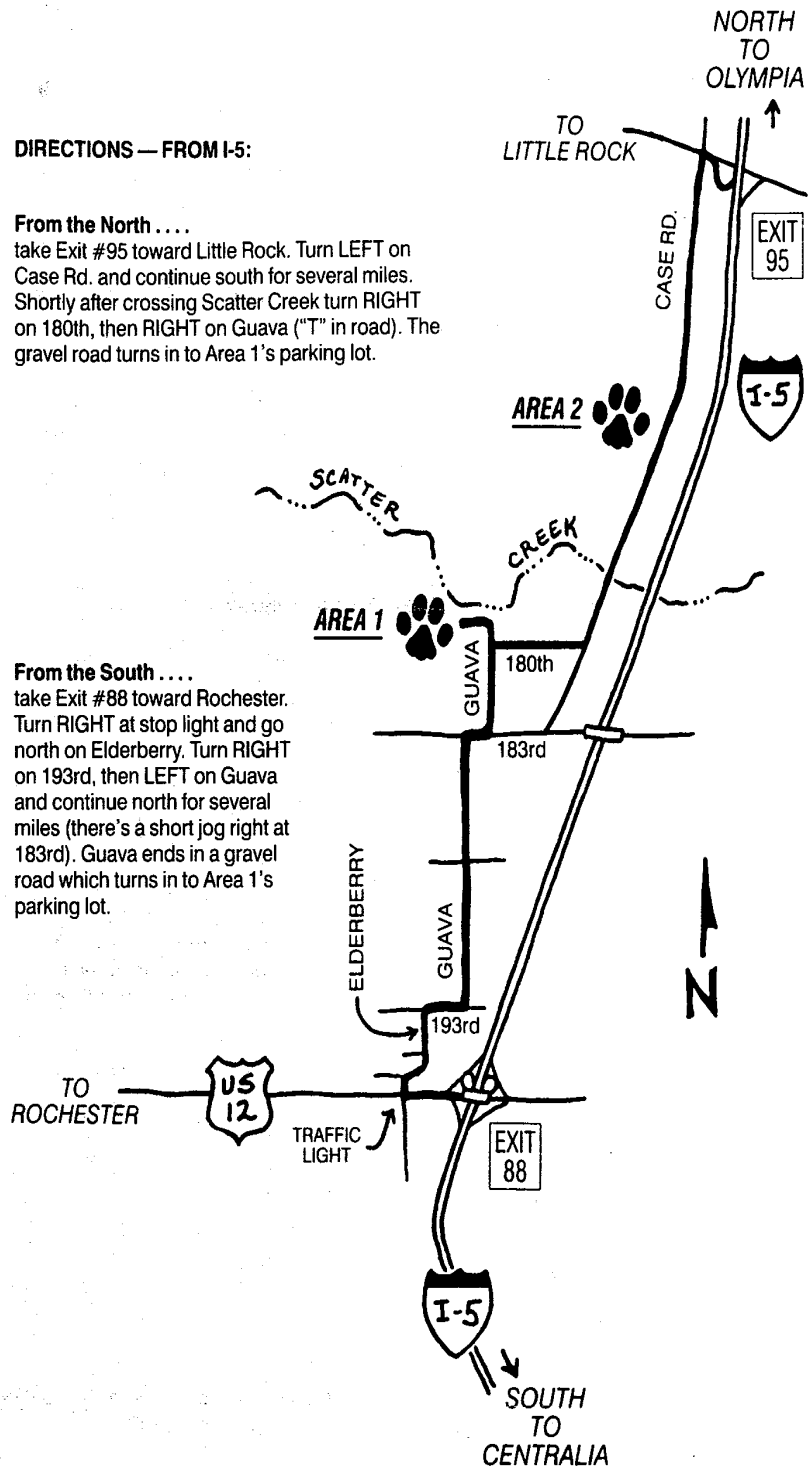
DIRECTIONS — FROM I-5:

take Exit #95 toward Little Rock. Turn LEFT on Case Rd. and continue south for several miles. Shortly after crossing Scatter Creek turn RIGHT on 180th, then RIGHT on Guava ("T" in road). The gravel road turns in to Area 1's parking lot.

From the South

take Exit #88 toward Rochester. Turn RIGHT at stop light and go north on Elderberry. Turn RIGHT on 193rd, then LEFT on Guava and continue north for several miles (there's a short jog right at 183rd). Guava ends in a gravel road which turns in to Area 1's parking lot.
